

Unit 4 My Favorite Moment in My Life

- **Subject:** Private Life / **Topic:** Favorite moment
- **Target Words:** moment, happen, past, fantastic, miss, lose, live, pony, present, amazing, experiment, downtown, yell, score, take a shower
- **Materials:** PPT tool (Writing on Grammar 3_Unit 4), CD player

★Brainstorming (pages 32-33)

Learn the Words

Have the students look at the words and the pictures. Ask the students to read the words before they choose the answer to each question. Then, read each word to the students and ask them to repeat the words out loud.

Warm-up

1. Have the students look at the pictures. Point to each picture and talk about it.

T: Look at the pictures. The girl is thinking about something. The album contains some pictures of her when she was a baby. She's thinking about her life as a baby. Look at the next two pictures. The girl who is wearing the jacket looks very happy. She is remembering something good that happened to her in the past. But the boy doesn't look happy at all. Did something bad happen to him? Let's move on to page 33. The boy who has a backpack is walking. How about the girl? She's going to go swimming with that tube. I hope she swims safely. What a cute little pony here! I love it. The boy looks so surprised in the last picture. What happened to him?

What did you see?

How did you feel at that time?

<p>1. Have the students turn to page 36.</p> <p>2. Tell the students to look at the grammar charts. Then, explain each grammar point on pages 36 and 37 by using the example sentences.</p> <p>T: Now, look at the first grammar point in this unit. We'll learn about the past continuous tense. Use the past continuous tense for actions that happened at a specific time in the past. To make the past continuous tense, use "was/were + -ing." The affirmative forms are "was/were + verb -ing," and for negatives, use "was not/were not + verb -ing." For yes/no questions, "Was/Were + S + verb -ing?" can be used. Now, complete the sentences by putting the verbs in the past continuous tense.</p> <p>T: Let's move on to the the next grammar point. It describes the differences between the past simple tense and the past continuous tense. You can use the past simple tense for actions that started in the past and ended in the past. And you can use the past continuous tense for actions that happened at a specific time in the past or for actions that happened at the same time as something else. For example, you can say, "He was studying English at 8:00 last night. "Last night" refers to a specific time in the past. Look at this sentence: "She was flying on a plane when I called her." The action of her flying on a plane happened at the same time that someone called her. Now, let's do the exercise. Circle the correct words.
